### **Equity Goal:**

The CTE Consortium is committed to eliminating gaps in opportunities and barriers to access which are highly predictable by students' race, ethnicity, gender, gender identity, socioeconomic status, and geographic location. We share the goal of improving outcomes for each and every student.

#### Consider:

- Both achievement and opportunity gaps that exist between historically and currently underserved students and their peers.
- Geographic barriers that limit access to opportunities.

#### Attend:

- When EACH and EVERY learner receives the necessary resources and supports, they are more likely to thrive.
- Recognize the unique value of CTE courses/programs and the unique role that CTE teachers play in the lives of their students.

#### Act:

- Work as a team to empower equity minded leadership: Accept our own biases, be willing to challenge status quo, build relational trust, be inclusive of all voices, be reflective and open to multiple perspectives to foster professional growth.
- Consider programs, projects, and initiatives to meet the changing needs of our region: Identify and engage historically and currently underserved students in all programs, projects, and initiatives.
- Implement programs/projects/initiatives: Identify and remove established mechanisms that perpetuate inequities within the communities being served. Use multiple data sources, including student voice and student data, to evaluate, refine and sustain effective efforts.
- Create a network of professionals who value and support
  culturally sustaining pedagogy: Consider all learners and encourage
  student self-efficacy, allow opportunities for participants to challenge
  implicit bias, and determine who benefits and who does not benefit from
  the experience.
- Express gratitude for opportunity to do this work: Acknowledge the
  role that adults play in affecting change, and recognize our spheres of
  influence within our locus of control.

- Reducing the predictability of who succeeds and who fails
- Creating change to support vulnerable and marginalized students
- Cultivating the unique gifts and talents of every student
